

A MESSAGE FROM PASTOR SURPRISES...

"Now on that same day, (of Christ's resurrection), two of Jesus' followers were going to a village called Emmaus, about seven miles from Jerusalem...." Luke 24:13



Present: Troy, Betsy, Roxanne, Jim, Laura, Rick, Pastor Steve

Meeting was called to order

Pastor Steve opened the meeting with a prayer

Jim made a motion to approve the secretary's report, while Betsy seconded. Motion passed

Troy made a motion to approve the Treasurer's report, while Betsy seconded. Motion passed

Troy mentioned during the Trustee report that Chris Larson had pumped the septic and there has not been another incident of water leaking into the church. Hoping to have Scott Thompson come and look at the leak in the hallway this spring as well.

It was discussed to encourage people to bring their own flowers by Saturday to use for decorations at the Easter service.

Pastor's report outlined the Luther Crest Leadership Training Proposal. Jim made a motion and Betsy seconded, to move forward with the training. Pastor will be meeting with both East and West to discuss the proposed dates in early fall for the trainings.

Deacon's Report was only to encourage additional people to sign up for readings a church.

New Business included the upcoming youth mission trip. Pastor reported that all chaperones will need to complete a background check prior to going. Laura made a motion and Betsy seconded to pay for pastor's portion of the mission trip which will come out of the church budget. Roxanne made a motion and Betsy seconded to pay for \$1350 of each of the SOTH youth attending the trip as well, which will come from the Luther League funds. Both motions passed. Once again want to thank the Showalter, Nelson, and Jergenson families for their generous donations within the omelet breakfast and Carol Hagemeyer's directly for the mission trip.

There was a conversation around communion moving forward. There was a motion from Jim and seconded by Betsy to move forward with regular communion following the Easter service, but also still have the option of the kits for people who feel more comfortable not gathering at the alter. Motion passed.

Summer church service schedule was discussed. The council asked Pastor Steve to propose to East and West Zion's that SOTH stick with the 9:30 service every other Sunday in order to stick with the same schedule. Pastor also asked if we would be open to having more services outside on the lawn at church and it was agreed to weather permitting.

Troy made a motion while Betsy seconded it to go ahead and purchase the \$300 software for Pastor Steve to be able to organize the services and display on the tv screen. This would decrease his Sunday prep work immensely. Motion passed.


